## SENATE BILLS

### Rape Victims' Right to Know

The PPAWI vote was to require hospitals to provide rape victims with information on and access to emergency contraception to prevent pregnancy after sexual assault. (2002 vote - SB 391)

### Contraceptive Coverage Equity

The PPAWI vote was to require employers who offer a prescription drug benefit to employees to include contraception. (2001 vote - SB 128)

### Mandatory 24 Hour Waiting Period and Lecture

The PPAWI vote was to respect women's ability to make responsible medical decisions, in consultation with their families and doctors, about abortion and pregnancy and to not mandate a 24 hour wait and state-directed lecture before a woman can obtain a legal abortion. (1996 vote - AB 441)

### Conceal & Carry Deadly Weapons Amendment to Exclude Health Care Facilities

The PPAWI vote was to continue to ban individuals from bringing lethal weapons such as handguns, knives and stun guns into health care facilities, including Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin and other family planning providers. (2003 vote - SB 214)

### Denial of Health Care

The PPAWI vote was to protect women's health by ensuring that health care workers, including doctors, continue to recommend or refer a pregnant woman for an abortion in emergency situations when her life or health is threatened by continuing a pregnancy. (2004 vote - AB 67)

## ASSEMBLY BILLS

### State Gag Rule

The PPAWI vote was to protect funding for Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin and other family planning providers who counsel patients on all of their pregnancy options. (2002 vote - AB 1)

### Contraceptive Coverage Equity

The PPAWI vote was to require employers who offer a prescription drug benefit to employees to include contraception. (2002 vote - AR 55)

### Mandatory 24 Hour Waiting Period and Lecture

The PPAWI vote was to respect women's ability to make responsible medical decisions, in consultation with their families and doctors, about abortion and pregnancy and to not mandate a 24 hour wait and state-directed lecture before a woman can obtain a legal abortion. (1996 vote - AB 441)

### Denial of Birth Control

The PPAWI vote was to ensure that pharmacists and other health care workers continue to provide comprehensive health care, including dispensing prescriptions for birth control. (2001 vote - SB 55)

### Denial of Health Care

The PPAWI vote was to protect women's health by ensuring that health care workers, including doctors, continue to recommend or refer a pregnant woman for an abortion in emergency situations when her life or health is threatened by continuing a pregnancy. (2003 vote - AB 67)
