Funding of Family Planning / Gag Rule The PPAWI vote was to protect funding of family planning programs that reduce unintended pregnancy and to ensure freedom of communication between physicians and patients. AA 14 to AA1 to ASA1 to AB1 2002 Special Session (2002)

Health Care Coverage for "Unborn" instead of Women The PPAWI vote was to maintain coverage of prenatal care for low-income women under the Medicaid Healthy Start program, rather than shift coverage to the "unborn" under BadgerCare. AA7to AA1 to ASA1 to AB1 2002 Special Session (2002)

Contraceptive Coverage Equity The PPAWI vote amended the women's health platform to include a call for insurance coverage of contraception. AR 55 (2002)

Denial of Woman's Right to Contraception The PPAWI vote was to ensure that pharmacists and other health care workers continue to provide comprehensive health care, including dispensing of contraception, to customers and patients. AA 22 to ASA 1 to SB 55 (2001)

Additional Restrictions on Minors' Access to Abortion The PPAWI vote was to maintain current law that allows for rare cases -- such as incest and suicidal behavior -- in which minors may seek an abortion by obtaining the consent of a close adult relative, a member of the clergy, a psychiatrist, or upon approval of the court. AB 312 (2000)

Denial of Prenatal Health Care The PPAWI vote was to protect the right of pregnant women to receive information about prenatal tests and their results. AB 535 (2000)

Ban on Abortion Procedures The PPAWI vote was to allow physicians to decide which abortion procedure is the safest and most appropriate for their patients and to keep abortion legal. AB 220 (1998)

24 Hour Waiting Period & Mandatory Lecture on Abortion The PPAWI vote was to respect women's moral capacity to decide, in consultation with their doctor, whether or not to terminate a pregnancy. AB 441 (1996)

Leadership Reward for 2001-2002 Session A 10% leadership reward was given to any legislator who: authored a PPAWI-supported bill or amendment, or provided critical leadership on a bill in committee or during floor debate.

Senate

Rape Victims' Access to Emergency Contraception The PPAWI vote was to require hospitals to provide rape victims with information and access to emergency contraception which prevents pregnancy after unprotected intercourse. SB 391 (2002)

Contraceptive Coverage Equity The PPAWI vote was to require insurance companies to cover prescription contraception to the same degree that they cover other prescription medication. SB 128 (2001)

Amendments to Ban on Abortion Procedures The PPAWI vote was to amend a bill to criminalize abortion by clearly defining which procedures are banned; allowing an exception for women's health; and reducing the penalty on a physician from life imprisonment to a two year sentence. AB 220 amendments (1998)

24 Hour Waiting Period & Mandatory Lecture on Abortion The PPAWI vote was to respect women's moral capacity to decide, in consultation with their doctor, whether or not to terminate a pregnancy. AB 441 (1996)

Amendments to Minors' Access to Abortion The PPAWI vote was to allow for rare cases -- such as incest and suicidal behavior -- in which minors may seek an abortion by obtaining the consent of a close adult relative, a member of the clergy, a psychiatrist, or upon approval of the court. AB 180 (1992)

Leadership Reward for 2001-2002 Session A 10% leadership reward was given to any legislator who: authored a PPAWI-supported bill or amendment, or provided critical leadership on a bill in committee or during floor debate.
